PARISH COUNCILLOR VACANCY

Notice of Casual vacancy to be filled by co-optation in the office of Councillor for the Parish of Alconbury.

The Returning Officer at the office of Huntingdonshire District Council has confirmed that there are vacant seats that resulted from the May 2022 elections and the Council can fill the casual vacancies by co-optation.

The council may co-opt any person who is legally qualified to hold such office, and who is willing to serve provided they are a British citizen, or a citizen of the Commonwealth or the European Union, and are neither the subject of a bankruptcy restriction order or interim order or have, within five years before the day of the election, been convicted in the United Kingdom of any offence and have had a prison sentence (whether suspended or not) for a period of over three months without the option of a fine. They must also be 18 years or older on the day they become nominated for co-optation.

Provided the person also satisfies at least ONE of the following:

- They are registered as a local government elector for the parish.
- They have during the whole of the preceding twelve months occupied as owner or tenant, any land or premises in the parish.
- Their principal or only place of work during the preceding twelve months has been in the parish.
- They have during the whole of the preceding twelve months resided in the parish or within 4.8 km of it.

Parish Council meetings are held on the fourth Tuesday of every month (except August) at 7.30pm.
